



# THE MSL-100, MSL-200 and MSL-300

look identical but they do have different functions.

## How do I determine if I have the MSL-100

Enter: \* then #

- **MSL-100:** after \* and # the keypad will beep three times along with three green flashes
- **MSL-200 and MSL-300:** after \* and # the keypad will do nothing

### THE MSL-100

- After you enter \* then # on the keypad you get three beeps along with three green flashes, you have a MSL-100.
- The top row of numbers on my keypad is 1,2,3.
- There is a OPEN and SET light on the keypad above the numbers 1,2,3.

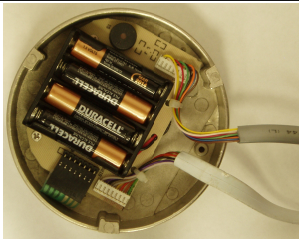
## How to determine if I have the MSL-200 or the MSL-300

Remove the keypad housing to expose the battery compartment:

- The **MSL-200** has two groups of wires going into the safe.
- The **MSL-300** has one group of wires going into the safe.



MSL-200

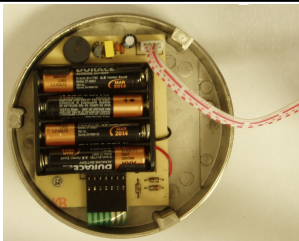


### THE MSL-200

- Remove the keypad housing and if you see two groups of wires going into your safe you have a MSL-200.
- The top row of numbers on my keypad is 1,2,3.
- After you enter \* then # on the keypad there is no beeps or flashes.

### THE MSL-300

- Remove the keypad housing and if you see one group of wires going into your safe you have a MSL-300.
- The top row of numbers on my keypad is 1,2,3.
- After you enter \* then # on the keypad there is no beeps or flashes.
